FINANCIAL SUMMARY

The finances to support activities fall into two categories:
Appliances and Cash donations

a) Appliances (wheelchairs and Prostheses)	
• Walkabout Foundation UK:	\$38,214
• Hand Project Germany:	\$742
b) Cash donation	
• Walkabout Foundation UK:	UGX 26,803,523
• Hand Project Germany:	\$3,573
• KCB Bank	UGX 454,875
• Crowd funding (YouCause, Benevity, Global Giving, Giving Way)	\$662

Most of these cash donations are for logistics and daily allowances to volunteers for the particular fixed period, usually less than 15 days.

In 2021 prostheses fitting camps for upper limb amputees were schedules in 5 locations:

Artificial limb fitting:

- Central (Kiruddu Nation referral hospital) 15 amputees were fitted
- Eastern (Iganga at St. Joseph's community centre) 18 amputees fitted
- Western (Rukungiri, St.Lwanga Karoli hospital) 20 fitted
- South Western (Kabale Referral hospital) 8 fitted
- South Western (Kisoro PWD centre) 10 fitted
