Position Summary:

We are seeking a highly motivated and skilled **Professional Physiotherapist** to join our team in Arua and Terego districts. The successful candidate will play a key role in providing physiotherapy services to individuals with disabilities, supporting home-based rehabilitation, and working collaboratively with families, caregivers, and community stakeholders to promote inclusion and independence.

- Conduct comprehensive assessments and develop personalized rehabilitation plans for clients.
